**BOILING** hot it may have been...but that didn't stop carp going on a bank holiday feeding spree over the weekend.

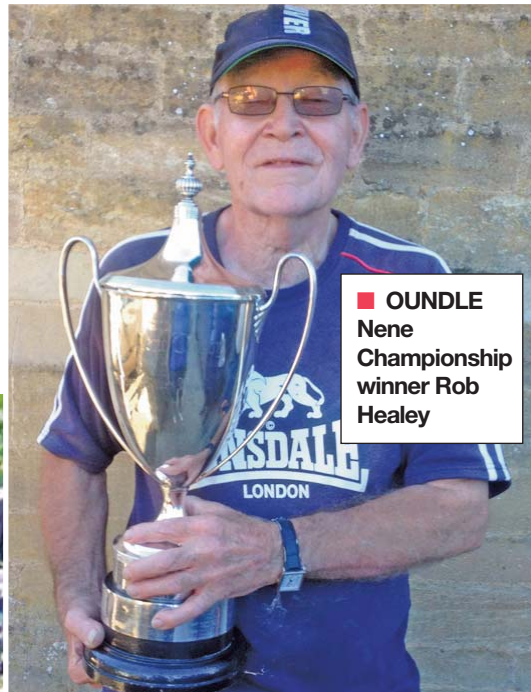
