Venue: GU Canal - Linford Boatyard

Following Linford AC's match where exceptional weights were recorded, all hopes for a continuation were sadly not to be found. As is the norm now, a good draw was vital and then anglers had to work hard to get any rewards. A very good turnout of 29 meant that an additional 5 pegs were placed towards Gifford Park and the rest through the boatyard and out towards Bolbeck Park and our grateful thanks are extended to Mick Heffron for his pegging out. All eyes were on who would be on the boats but this proved to be a most unproductive and hugely disappointing area for those there.

Mr Unstoppable Ernie Sattler the man on top form at present made no mistake from a good draw just past the boats to take a Bream and a Tench on pellet before finding the fish disappearing and resorting to bread punch found some good sample roach and another Tench to top the weights on the day. Next door and following the same pattern, Mick Heffron also had an early Bream on pellet and then additional fish falling to the punch. Meanwhile, between the bridges Roger Tebbut persevered when boats trashed his swim time after time to steadily put fish in the net. Further down, Dick Peerless was catching where those around him were struggling for bites and on the boats, Ron Hedges found a couple of better samples to make his push on the frame. On the Gifford side, Steve Emmerton caught a superb roach which tipped the scales at 1lb 3ozs and then lost a good bream next put in - both fish falling for his tried and tested red worm (must locate his compost heap).

First on the boats, Roy (Didder) Heffron had to extend his fishing line to 16 metres before he caught and then built a commendable weight. At the all-out, the final weights were as follows:

B Section	Roger Tebbut	6lbs 4ozs
